

Report on Feedback received from Teachers, Alumni, Students on curriculum and Student Satisfaction Survey

All feedback were received through Google Form and the links were distributed to the teachers by email and other links were initially posted in Academic Committee WhatsApp group and subsequently distributed by Departmental Heads to respective WhatsApp groups. Feedback from Teachers were sorted out department wise and initial analysis was done by pie charts with the help of Computer Science Department. Auto-generated Pie chart analysis of the feedback are initially done by Google Form. For clarity of analysis of such huge data, majority voice in choice of answers is accomplished in a matrix form in which the presence of numerals '1' represents the choice of majority in option-1, '2' represents option-2 and similarly '3' represents option-3. In case of tie, numerals '1,2' represents that equal majority has opted for option-1 and option-2.

Department of Economics, Physical Education and Physics have opted option-3 for question 4 (course curriculum sufficient to generate employability skill among the students). Economics, Mathematics, Physics and Zoology departments have opted option-3 for question 5 (current syllabus is sufficient to develop industry-academia linkage). Question 6 related to the ICT facilities availability in the College for teaching learning process, Computer Science and Physical Education departments have opted option-3 while Sociology Dept. has opted option-4. On question 7 related to sufficiency of Library resources, Dept. of Botany

opted option-3, Physical Education and Sociology opted option-4. Physical Education Dept. on Question -8 (Action plan taken by College on implementation of the course curriculum) and Question-9 (regular meeting for effective implementation of course curriculum) has opted option-1 & option-3. Computer Science Department on question-10 (departmental needs catered by the College) have opted for option-2 & option-3.

Overall, most of the departments have opted option-1 and option-2 to the questions related to curriculum and the facilities extended by the College. Departments who have opted for option-3 and option-4 for questions 1-5 could take up the matter with their respective UG Board of studies. For questions 6-10, wherever departments have opted option-3 and option-4, their problems should be addressed by the College authorities.

Feedback was taken from the students of 6th Semester. In general, students have positively opted for option-1 and option-2. Wherever they have opted for option-3 and option-4 are taken into consideration for further analysis.

Feedback from students of Hons. Course - Students of Computer Science Dept. has opted for option-3 for questions 2 (allocation of hours and credits) & question -5 (curriculum sufficient to bridge the gap between academic and employment opportunities) while students of Economics Dept. has opted for option-3 for the first five questions. Department of English, Environmental Science and Geography also opted for option-3 for question-5. Geography Dept. has also opted for option-2 & option-3 for the last question-10 regarding adequacy of Library materials and teaching learning resources offered by the College. Departmental Heads of the above departments, where students have opted for option-3, should discuss with their students and wherever applicable should inform their respective Board of Studies to take appropriate measures. Library facility and teaching learning resources for Geography Dept. needs to be made adequate after consultation with the Librarian and the faculty members. No feedback was received from Sociology Department.

Feedback from students of Programme Course - Received mixed responses from three Programme course students of Economics Dept. where they have opted for option-1, option-2 and option-3 for questions 2,4,5, 9 and 10. Similar mixed responses is observed from the two responses received from students of English Dept.

Feedback from students of GE Course - Students from GE course of English Dept. has opted for option-3 for questions 1,2,3,5,8 and 10. Departmental Heads of Economics and English departments are advised to find the cause of such response and take necessary measures.

Feedback from students of PG Course – Students from the three PG courses have all opted for option-1 or option-2.

English Dept. students have opted for option 1&3 for question-3 and question-5. Physics Dept. programme course students opted for option 2& 3 for question-9. Sociology students have opted for option-3 for question-7 and option-1,2&3 for question 8. Departmental Heads should take note of the questions where students have opted for option-3 and take necessary steps for a better teaching learning experience.

Feedback of Student satisfaction Survey (GE) – Students of English Dept. have opted for option-3 for question-7 and question-9. Department should take initiative to address the students problem in those areas.

Feedback of Student satisfaction Survey (PG) – Students of PG departments are very satisfied with the teaching learning process as it is reflected by their choice of option-1 to most of the questions.
